

NEPEAN RINGETTE ASSOCIATION TOURNAMENT

REGISTRATION

All the Nepean teams should register for the Nepean Tournament (see link on NRA website to register) electronically as soon as possible after the beginning of the season. This will ensure that all the teams will receive emails regarding tournament details, and that accurate team information is published in programs/on the Score2Stats website.

SCHEDULE/Timekeepers, Scorekeepers, Shotclock Operators

Each team will be responsible for volunteer hours (3-4 hours per player). The hours are to be divided up as evenly as possible amongst the team members. All slots must be filled in by your team. If necessary, you can arrange to trade spots with other teams (this is your responsibility, not the responsibility of the scheduler). IF YOUR ASSIGNED TIME SLOT IS NOT COVERED, THERE IS A FINE OF \$50 per SLOT, which will be deducted from your team deposit. Forms are available at the arenas to complete to identify who did not cover their assigned shift. Timekeepers, Scorekeepers, and Shotclock Operators need to be experienced - we encourage all new parents or players interested in doing these tasks to learn from an experienced person on their team prior to the tournament. Training will be made available if required before the tournament. Please note that parents should not ask their young children to do their volunteer hours for them, as many of these tasks require the maturity of an adult or mature teenager.

FUNDRAISING TABLES (proceeds to individual teams)

Teams can arrange to have a table for fundraising purposes in the upstairs mezzanine between the ice surfaces at Walter Baker, Saturday (all day) and Sunday AM (if desired). IMPORTANT: Merchandise to be sold must be pre-approved by the tournament committee. NOTE: As per the contract agreements with on-site vendors, teams should not sell muffins, drinks, or any other items that are sold by the vendors at the arena - as in the past, the craft fair may be taking place on Saturday. Teams are not to sell anything in the stands during games.

MUFFINS

Each FAMILY (not per player) is asked to provide one-dozen individually wrapped NUT-FREE muffins for the tournament. The muffins are to be delivered to the arena of your team's first game of the tournament. It is also helpful to label them according to flavor as well. The muffins have been well-received by participating teams in the past, and all of them are gone by the end of the weekend (sometimes even sooner).

PRIZE TABLE (proceeds to NRA)

Each team is to provide two gifts with a total value of \$40.00. If not received by the Prize table coordinators by the deadline, the gifts will be purchased by the coordinators, with an additional \$20.00 surcharge. The total cost of your gift will then become \$60.00. This amount will be deducted from your team refund at the end of the year. Any leftover Halloween candy may also be donated to make extra gifts for the table.

HIGH SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS

High school volunteers are needed to man the penalty box doors, clean up changing rooms between teams, etc. These hours can be used towards the volunteer hours at school.
